ABOUT MAUI

Maui is the most visited of all Hawaiian Islands. It is sparsely populated supporting less than one-tenth of the state's population. It is home to pineapple, sugar cane, cattle ranches, and rain forests. Kahului was a sugar town by 1880; however, real growth has only come during the last 20 years. Also of distinction is Haleakala, the largest dormant volcano in the world, consisting of 30,000 feet of hardened lava rising from the ocean floor capped by a huge crater. Maui is the second largest island in the Hawaiian chain. It is estimated that 50% of the world's humpback whales return to Maui's warm waters where they were born and to mate. Kahului is located on the northern coast of the island on Kahului Bay. During the 1960's, Kahului experienced a growth period mainly due to a large scale-planning project sponsored by the Hawaiian and Commercial Sugar Company. Maui's principle airport is also located in Kahului. Before the city of Lahaina, which is Maui's main city, became a thriving missionary and whaling village, it was the home of Hawaiian kings and queens. Today, Lahaina hums with vibrant tourist activity. Lahaina, often called the "jewel in the crown of Maui," is the second most visited spot on Maui after the beaches.

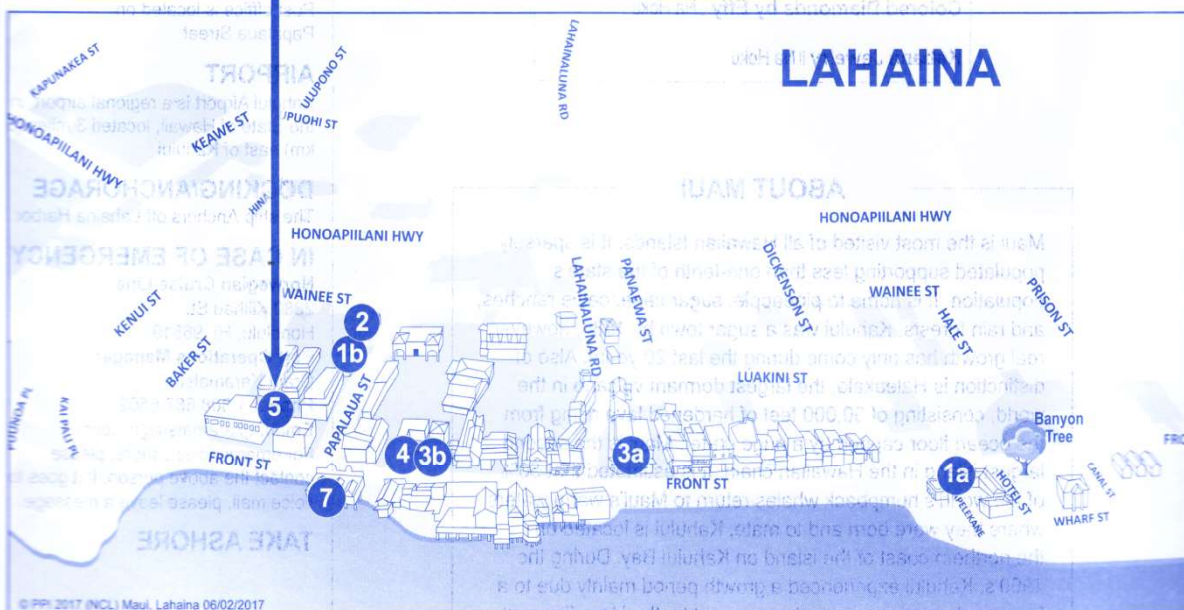

ABOUT HILO

Hilo is the oldest port of entry with a population of 38,000, and is the second largest city in Hawaii situated on the east coast of the Hawaii Island (The Orchid Island). It accounts for 63% of the state, about 4,000 square miles. Shipping and diversified agriculture is significant, plus there's a campus for the University of Hawaii in Hilo. It is believed this was the first island to be inhabited by Polynesian voyagers from the Marquesas Islands, around 700 A.D. Hilo is America's wettest city, over 120 inches annually, and holds the record for the most rain in 24 hours (22.3 inches), set in 1979.

Hilo is the gateway to Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, America's most exciting national park, where Kilauea Volcano has erupted every day since 1983. Its name means "The Spewing." The volcanic peak of Mauna Kea is 31,796 feet tall from the ocean floor, 2,700 feet taller than Mt. Everest. Near its top is a Lake Waiau, highest in the state and the third highest in the USA. The island's other major peak, Mauna Loa (Long Mountain) is the largest active volcano comprised of 10,000 cubic miles of iron-hard lava – the densest and most massive mountain on earth. Hawaii's largest "small" town lies at the feet of three volcanoes, Mauna Kea, the world's tallest; Mauna Loa, the world's most voluminous; and Kilauea, the world's most active volcano. Kilauea is Hawaii's biggest visitor attraction and is located due south in Hawaii Volcanoes National Park.

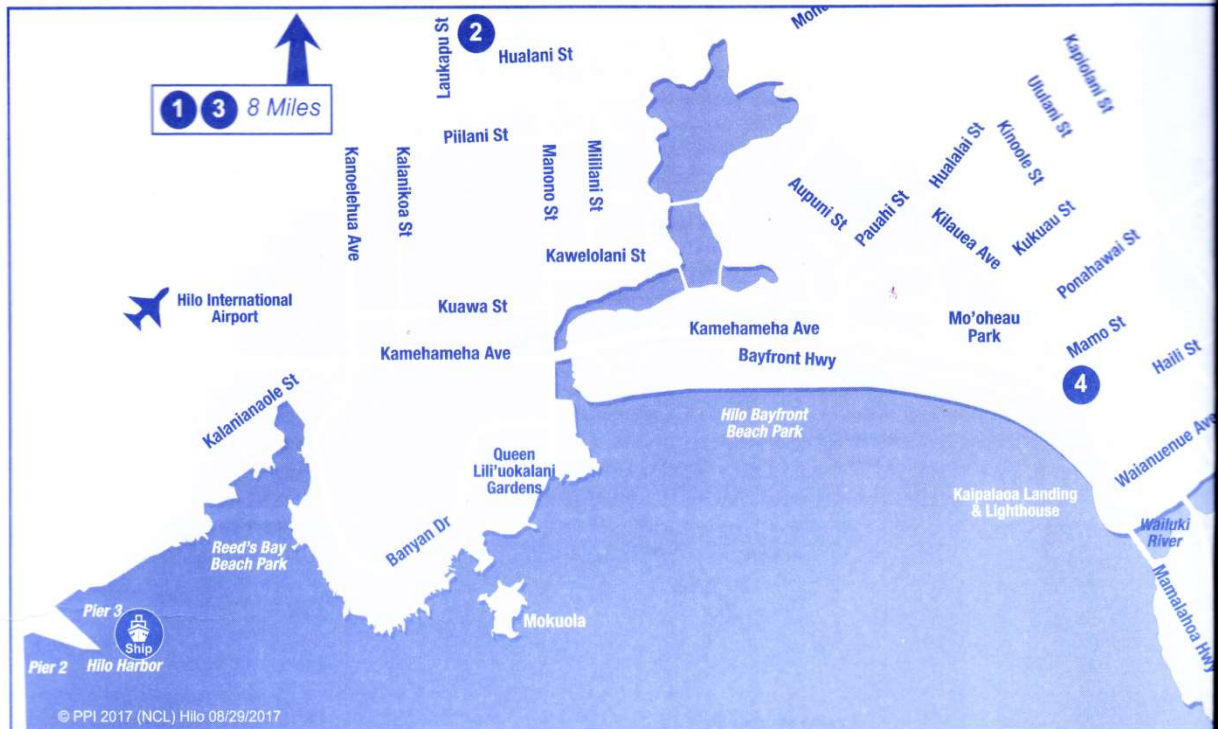

ABOUT KAILUA-KONA

Kona is one word everyone seems to know, synonymous with great coffee and big fish.

The Hawaii Island embodies what the Hawaiians call "mana," a sense of spirituality that is still apparent through acres of petroglyphs etched in the black lava landscape. About 20 miles south of Kona is Kealahou Bay, the place where Captain James Cook arrived in 1778. He was honored as the Hawaiian god Lono, but less than a month later he was killed. Cook was searching for a northwest passage to England and came south to these islands seeking shelter from the winter months. The memorial to Captain Cook stands at the site of excellent snorkeling and diving. Soak up the area's stunning beaches—white sand, black sand, and a variety of shades inbetween. Don't forget the waterfalls, volcanoes, luaus, seahorse farm, whale and dolphin sightings, sea turtles, and of course, Kona coffee.

Kona means "leeward side" in Hawaiian. The Hawaii Island's population is about 150,000, the least populated island per square mile. Most live in Hilo and what is called the Kohala-Kona coast. The island is more than twice the size of all the islands combined. Downtown Kona's highest structure is one of prettiest—Mokuiaikaua Church, the oldest house of Christian worship in Hawaii. Visit the Hulihe'e Palace of King Kalakaua.

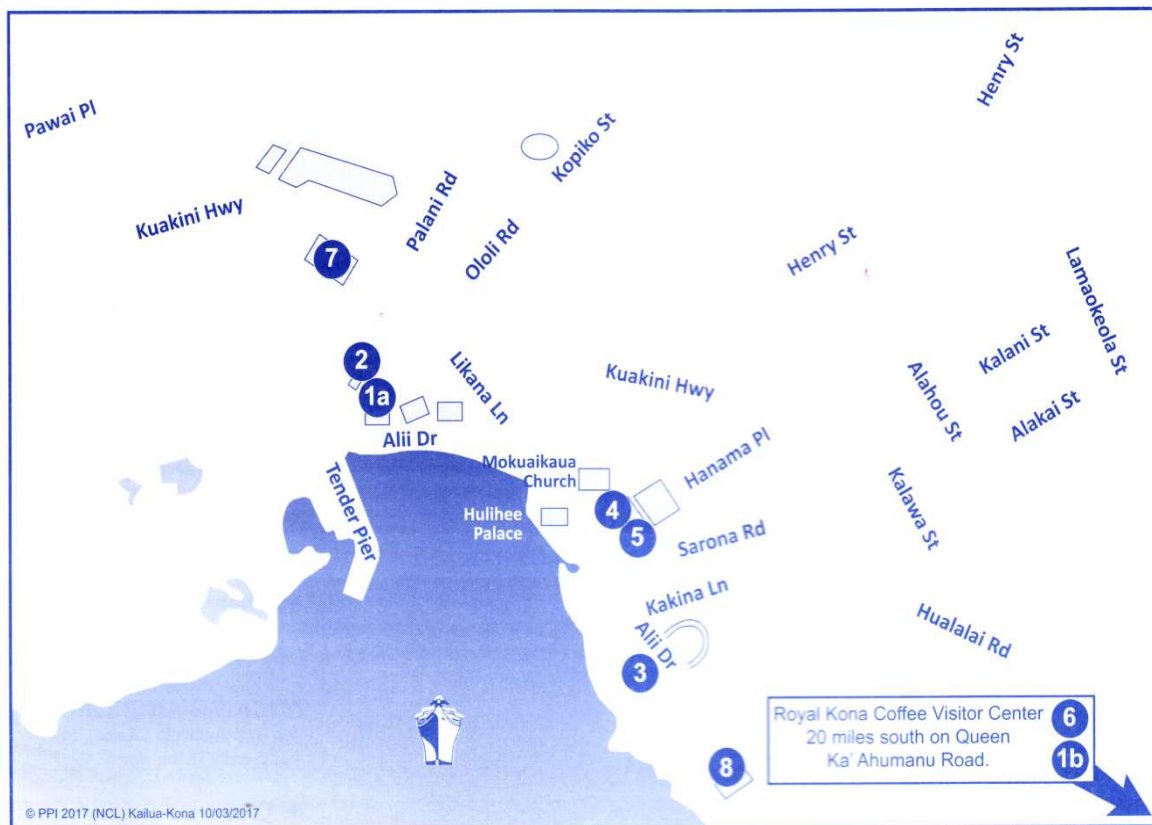

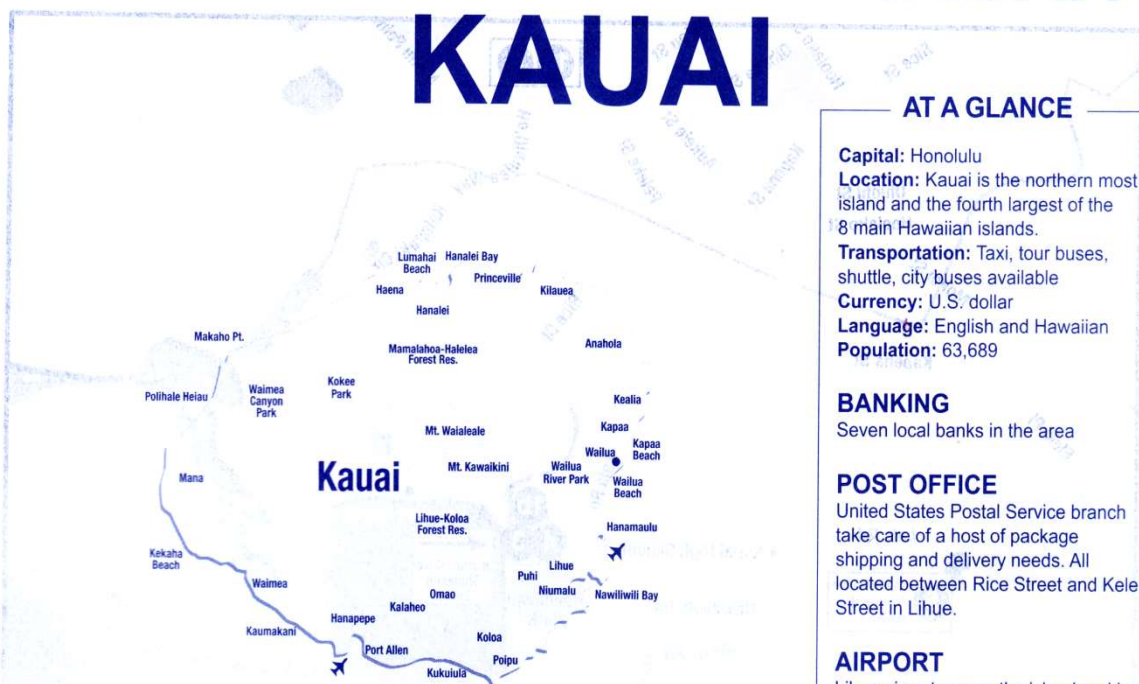

ABOUT KAUAI

Kauai's first settlers arrived around 500 A.D., approximately 500 years before the rest of the islands were settled. Through a succession of kings, the island prospered. Captain James Cook landed on Kauai first, coming ashore at Waimea in 1778. Kauai is also known for being the only island that resisted take over attempts by King Kamehameha during his quest to unify the islands under one rule. The island remained an independent kingdom until 1810. Kauai is the smallest of the four major islands covering 552 square miles.

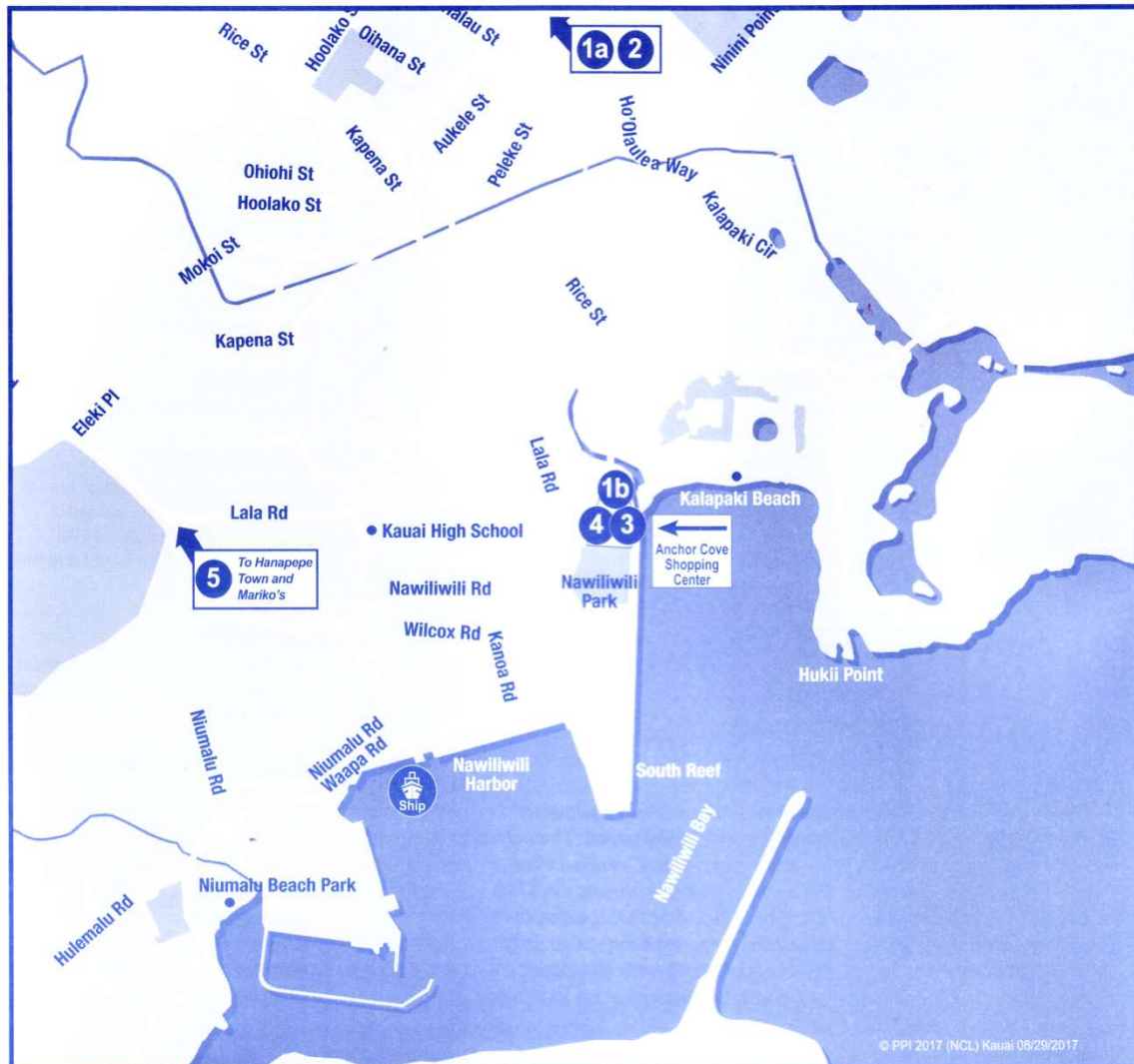
Kauai is the oldest and most northerly of the Hawaiian Islands, famous for Waimea Canyon, the "Grand Canyon of the Pacific." Kauai's craggy mountains, gorgeous valleys, and many breezy beaches have managed to avoid excessive development. Much of Kauai looks just like it did when the first Polynesians paddled up to the shore. Of course, there are resorts, hotels, and some of the island's best golf courses, however, no building on Kauai is allowed to rise above the level of the coconut trees. As a result, you are assured of several WOW moments as you experience the extreme beauty of Kauai. The east shore offers the majesty of the Wailua Falls and Fern Grotto.
